### LRRWMO Permit #2022-04 ~ Riverdale Drive Extension ~ Ramsey

Linton reviewed the April 7, 2022 memo from Barr Engineering in which Barr Engineering recommends that the LRRWMO approve of the permit for this project subject to six conditions detailed in the memorandum.

Weaver asked for details on the standards the road would be constructed to. Linton confirmed that the road would be constructed to Municipal State Aid (MSA) standards.

Holthus asked if this road would provide access to a new development. Linton confirmed that this would provide access to the new Capstone development, as well as other existing properties.

Weaver referenced the County-owned property that was previously identified as a potential bridge link into Hennepin County. He asked if this plan would impact the feasibility of that connection. Musgrove provided additional clarification on the potential location for that link, should it be feasible in the future.
