CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Debra Musgrove called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. in the Committee Room of Anoka City Hall.

ROLL CALL

Also present were: Deputy Treasurer Lori Yager, Ramsey Civil Engineer IV Leonard Linton, Anoka Engineering Technician Ben Nelson, Stephanie Johnson of Barr Engineering, Andover Natural Resources Technician Kameron Kytonen, Becky Wozney of Anoka Conservation District, Colleen Werdien of Anoka Conservation District, and Jamie Foust representing Aldi.

APPROVE AGENDA

Motion was made by Holthus, seconded by Musgrove, to approve the August 17, 2023 agenda as presented. Vote: 2 ayes, 0 nays. Motion carried.

<u>APPROVE MINUTES</u> July 20, 2022 Regular Meeting

Motion was made by Holthus, seconded by Musgrove, to approve the July 20, 2023 Regular Meeting minutes as presented. Vote: 2 aves, 0 nays. Motion carried.

August 1, 2022 Special Meeting

Motion was made by Holthus, seconded by Musgrove, to approve the August 1, 2023 Special Meeting minutes as presented. Vote: 2 ayes, 0 nays. Motion carried.

FINANCE MATTERS

Treasurer's Report

Yager presented the Treasurer's Report for the period ending July 31, 2023. Account balances for the period were: Checking, \$135,490.80; less permit account balance of (\$47,706.75); less Generation Plan reserves of (\$29,493.43), for a total balance of \$58,290.72.

Musgrove asked and received confirmation that the charges for the special meeting requested by Home2Suites would be charged to the applicant. Yager noted that would show on the next invoice.

Motion was made by Holthus, seconded by Musgrove, to accept the Treasurer's Report for the period ending July 31, 2023. Vote: 2 ayes, 0 nays. Motion carried.

Payment of Bills

Yager presented the payment of bills for TimeSaver in the amount of \$935.07 (professional services) and Barr Engineering in the amount of \$4,877.50 (July 2023 engineering).

Motion was made by Holthus, seconded by Musgrove, to authorize payment as presented and indicated above. Vote: 2 ayes, 0 nays. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

LRRWMO Permit #2023-09R ~ Legacy at Petersen Farms ~ Andover

Kytonen reviewed the August 9, 2023 memo from Barr Engineering in which Barr Engineering stated that the applicant has indicated their preliminary schedule is to begin site grading after Labor Day. With the continuance of this permit, a special meeting request prior to the September meeting is anticipated. However, since the 60-day review period will end on September 12, which is prior to the LRRWMO's September 21 meeting, a time review extension for an additional 60-days is recommended.

Johnson acknowledged that this has been going on for quite some time. She commented that this is a large development with a lot of ponding and while the list of issues are getting smaller, there are still some details to be worked out.

Wozney stated that the additional extension would then expire on November 12th if granted today.

Motion was made by Holthus, seconded by Musgrove, to grant an additional 60-day extension and continue Permit #2023-09R, Legacy at Petersen Farms, Andover, as detailed in the Barr Engineering memorandum dated August 9, 2023. Vote: 2 ayes, 0 nays. Motion carried.

LRRWMO Permit #2023-08 ~ Soderholm Building Addition ~ Ramsey

Linton reviewed the August 9, 2023 memo from Barr Engineering in which Barr Engineering recommends that the LRRWMO approve of the permit for this project subject to 11 conditions detailed in the memorandum.

Musgrove asked for more details on the discharge. Linton commented that the site will provide a lot of stormwater ponding onsite and noted that this applicant is very efficient with their stormwater.

Motion was made by Holthus, seconded by Musgrove, to approve Permit #2023-08, Soderholm Building Addition, Ramsey, subject to eleven (11) conditions as detailed in the Barr Engineering memorandum dated August 9, 2023. Vote: 2 ayes, 0 nays. Motion carried.

LRRWMO Permit #2023-11 ~ 167th Avenue Reconstruction ~ Ramsey

Linton reviewed the August 10, 2023 memo from Barr Engineering in which Barr Engineering recommends that the LRRWMO approve of the wetland boundaries and types and the no-loss as documented in the draft WCA Notice of Decision.

Motion was made by Holthus, seconded by Musgrove, to approve the wetland boundaries and types and no-loss as documented in the WCA Notice of Decision for Permit #2023-11, 167th Avenue Reconstruction, Ramsey, as detailed in the Barr Engineering memorandum dated August 10, 2023. Vote: 2 ayes, 0 nays. Motion carried.

LRRWMO Permit #2023-12 ~ The COR Grading ~ Ramsey

Linton reviewed the August 11, 2023 memo from Barr Engineering in which Barr Engineering recommends that the LRRWMO approve the WCA no-loss with the condition that the project will not result in indirect impacts to the WCA regulated wetland areas as described in the draft Notice of Decision.

Motion was made by Holthus, seconded by Musgrove, to approve the WCA no-loss with the condition that the project will not result in indirect impacts to the WCA regulated wetland areas as described in the WCA Notice of Decision for Permit #2023-12, The COR Grading, Ramsey, as detailed in the Barr Engineering memorandum dated August 11, 2023. Vote: 2 ayes, 0 nays. Motion carried.

<u>LRRWMO Permit #2023-13 ~ COR Waterfront Infrastructure Improvements – Erosion and</u> <u>Sediment Control Permit ~ Ramsey</u>

Linton reviewed the August 11, 2023 memo from Barr Engineering in which Barr Engineering recommends that the LRRWMO approve of the permit for this project subject to 13 conditions detailed in the memorandum.

Musgrove asked for details on the work that has been occurring. Linton noted that was tree removal and grading would start in the next week or so if the permit is approved.

Johnson noted that this is a large project where the grading was requested first to begin with that, and the stormwater permit will come forward at a future time. She noted that the last two conditions are meant to keep the project moving and keep communication open. She commented that the waterfront pond will be a large regional pond intended to serve the intention of the original ponds. She stated that three ponds will be filled, noting that only one of those is currently serving a stormwater management purpose.

Motion was made by Holthus, seconded by Musgrove, to approve Permit #2023-13, COR Waterfront Infrastructure Improvements – Erosion and Sediment Control, Ramsey, subject to thirteen (13) conditions as detailed in the Barr Engineering memorandum dated August 11, 2023. Vote: 2 ayes, 0 nays. Motion carried.

LRRWMO Permit #2023-14 ~ Aldi ~ Ramsey

Linton reviewed the August 11, 2023 memo from Barr Engineering in which Barr Engineering recommends that the LRRWMO approve of the permit for this project subject to nine conditions detailed in the memorandum.

Johnson provided clarification on the phasing and platting of this project, noting that this request is for the first phase and the applicant would be coming back in the future. Motion was made by Holthus, seconded by Musgrove, to approve Permit #2023-14, Aldi, Ramsey, subject to nine (9) conditions as detailed in the Barr Engineering memorandum dated August 11, 2023. Vote: 2 ayes, 0 nays. Motion carried.

LRRWMO Permit #2023-15 ~ Waltek Site Imp ~ Ramsey

Linton reviewed the August 15, 2023 memo from Barr Engineering in which Barr Engineering stated that review comments have been sent to the project agent, Craig Jochum, Hakanson Anderson, requesting additional information be provided for the application to be considered completed. It is requested that the LRRWMO continue this item and that the review period be extended by 60-days as required by MN Statutes 15.99, until a revised submittal is provided for review.

Motion was made by Holthus, seconded by Musgrove, to extend the review period by 60days and continue Permit #2023-15, Waltek Site Imp, Ramsey, as detailed in the Barr Engineering memorandum dated August 15, 2023. Vote: 2 ayes, 0 nays. Motion carried.

LRRWMO Permit #2023-16 ~ 167th Avenue Erosion Control ~ Ramsey

Linton reviewed the August 8, 2023 memo from Barr Engineering in which Barr Engineering recommends that the LRRWMO approve of the permit for this project subject to seven conditions detailed in the memorandum.

Motion was made by Holthus, seconded by Musgrove, to approve Permit #2023-16, 167th Avenue Erosion Control, Ramsey, subject to seven (7) conditions as detailed in the Barr Engineering memorandum dated August 8, 2023. Vote: 2 ayes, 0 nays. Motion carried.

Wozney commented she thinks that they would but noted the challenges they would have in funding that position in a more creative manner because there are not direct permit fees that could fund that position.

Memorandum

The applicant is proposing the reconstruction of a damaged building, associated pavement construction and site grading on a parcel at the address 14310 Sunfish Lake Boulevard NW within the City of Ramsey. The site is bounded by 144th Avenue, Azurite Street, and Sunfish Lake Boulevard. The proposed project will disturb approximately 1.7 acres (35%) of the +/- 4.9-acre site. Stormwater management for the site is proposed to be provided within an infiltration basin and forebay located in the southeast corner of the property. Impervious disconnection and a swale will also provide stormwater management for parts of the site that do not drain to the proposed infiltration basin. The stormwater basin will provide rate control and water quality management for the eastern portion of the site. Outflow discharges from the stormwater basins in the form of a natural channel overflow will be directed to the wetland south of the site. Some offsite areas that drain onto the site and are included in the HydroCAD model to evaluate the peak elevations observed in the basin.

The project will involve a 0.2-acre reduction in total impervious area from 2.5 acres to 2.3 acres (resulting in 47% overall site impervious). Because this is a redevelopment project that is not disturbing more than 50% of the existing site area, the LRRWMO's volume control requirements are not applicable for the project. The LRRWMO's other stormwater management and erosion and sediment control requirements do apply.

The SSURGO websoil survey identifies the underlying on-site soil as Type A soils. No borings were collected for the site. Because borings were not collected to determine the underlying soils, the lowest infiltration rate established by the MPCA for Type A soils of 0.8 inches/hour is assumed below the infiltration basin.

Stormwater discharges from the site in four primary locations. The east side of the property discharges to the infiltration basin used for stormwater management. Attenuation of the additional runoff directed to this low area will be controlled by raising the overflow from the low area. A comparison of the preand post-construction discharges for the 2-, 10-, and 100-year design storm events at all four offsite discharge locations is shown in the following table. As shown, the total peak discharge from the site is less than existing conditions:

For water quality, the results of a MIDS calculator shows compliance with the LRRWMO water quality requirements. The MIDS calculator shows the proposed on-site stormwater management facilities will provide an annual removal efficiency of 90% for total suspended solids and 77% for total phosphorous.

The HydroCAD modeling provided shows 100-year frequency elevations for the stormwater basin as indicated in the table below. The proposed finished floor elevation of the nearest building and separation from the 100-year high water level are also listed. As shown, the 100-year elevation in the basin does not exceed the required freeboard. The building finish floor elevations have at least 12.7 feet of freeboard from the high water of the basin.

The erosion and sediment control plan shows silt fence on the downgradient perimeter of the construction extents, inlet protection, and a scour prevention flexamat on the stormwater basin overflow. Two rock construction entrances are provided at the entryway onto the site from two locations along 144th Avenue.

It is our recommendation that the LRRWMO approve of the permit for this project subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The vertical datum must be noted on the Plans.
- 2. Rip-rap be placed at the flared end section to the basin forebay.
- 3. Erosion control measures must be installed at the initial stage of site grading operations.
- 4. Upon completion of construction and restoration of disturbed areas, the permit applicant is responsible for the removal of all erosion control measures installed throughout the construction site.

- 5. Upon completion of construction and restoration of disturbed areas, the permit applicant is responsible for the decompaction of all proposed infiltration areas.
- 6. To minimize the potential of material from leaving the site and being tracked onto the roadway, the rock filter construction entrance being a minimum of two feet in height and having side slopes of 4:1 must be constructed at the entryway onto the site. The rock construction entrance will provide an erosion control facility and enable construction traffic to enter the site.
- 7. Street sweeping must be undertaken and completed on an as needed basis.
- Compliance with the storm water management requirements of the Lower Rum River Watershed Management Organization is to be administered for this project by the City of Ramsey.
- The storm water management plan for future development has assumed an imperviousness of 47%. Site development that exceeds an impervious area of 47% must provide an updated storm water management plan showing the LRRWMO criteria is met.
- 10. In all cases where the doing by the permittee of anything authorized by this permit shall involve the taking, using, or damaging of any property, rights or interests of any other person or persons, or of any publicly owned lands or improvements or interests, the permittee; before proceeding; shall obtain the written consent of all persons, agencies, or authorities concerned, and shall acquire all necessary property rights and interest.

On Seeptmber 8, 2022, the LRRWMO board made a motion supporting the proposed legislation being pursued by the City of Anoka and area state legislators in order to improve the safety and fuctionlity of the City of Anoka Dam on the Rum River. And on May 23, 2023, the State Bonding Bill was presented to the Governor Dayton and on May 24, 2023 he signed the State Bonding Bill into law. As part of the bill, there was \$500,000 granted to the City of Anoka for feasibility studies for the design, engineering, and environmental analysis for the repair and reconstruction of the Rum River Dam. See attached *City of Anoka – Rum River Dam* Legislative Brochure.

On July 10, 2023, Anoka's State of Minnesota 2024 Capital Budget request was officially part of the Capital Budget System. And on September 13, 2023, the Capital Investment Committee Legislative Bus Tour stopped at the Anoka Dam.

On September 18, 2023, Anoka City Council adopted a resolution supporting the 2024 Capital Budget General Obligation Bonding request for the Anoka Rum River Dam Reconstruction and Modification Project.

The City of Anoka is requesting Letters of Support from the Lower Rum River Watershed Management Orgination, the City of Andover, and the City of Ramsey for the Anoka Rum River Dam Reconstruction and Modification Project. Attached is a letter of support template for your reference and/or your use if the project is supported by your organization. The deadline for Anoka staff to submit these letters is October 13, 2023.

AMENDED AND RESTATED JOINT AND COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE LOWER RUM RIVER WATERSHED MANAGEMENT ORGANIZATION TO PLAN, CONTROL, AND PROVIDE FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE LOWER RUM RIVER WATERSHED

PREFACE

The Lower Rum River Watershed lying East of the Mississippi River is a watershed that is basically a direct tributary to the Mississippi River. It encompasses all or parts of the cities of Andover, Anoka and Ramsey (the "Member Cities").

Minnesota Laws of 1982, Chapter 509, now codified as Minnesota Statutes 2012, Sections 103B.201 through 103B.255 mandated that all watersheds within the seven county Metropolitan area must be governed by a watershed management organization. The Watershed is authorized to organize under a joint powers' agreement pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Sections 471.59 and 103B.211. If such an organization is not created, Anoka County shall petition for the establishment of a watershed district under Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 103D. All the cities in the Lower Rum River Watershed expressed a desire in 1985 to create a joint powers group rather than a watershed district and now desire to adopt an amended joint powers agreement to establish a watershed management organization, which will comply with the current law for management of the watershed. It is the belief of these three cities that a joint powers group will provide more efficient planning and administration of the Lower Rum River Watershed if the watershed is managed under a joint powers' agreement. The goal is to leave as much control as possible with the three individual Member Cities.

It has been determined by the three Member Cities that they desire to proceed under a Joint Powers Agreement rather than under Minnesota Statues, Chapter 103D as a watershed district. Each party to this agreement has been fully advised that the watershed management organizations being created shall have the powers and responsibilities set forth in the Metropolitan Surface water Management Act, Minnesota Statues, Sections 103B.201 through 103B.255 and as amended by this Agreement. It is further understood and agreed that it is the intent of this agreement to assign to the watershed management organization, which has operated since 1985, the additional powers and duties assigned by the Minnesota legislature. The management of the water resources is a rapidly changing field and new laws and regulations are being adopted and amended frequently and it should not be necessary to amend this agreement every time the legislature enacts a new law.

Each member City further recognizes that this is a binding contract and failure to cooperate or to carry out a Member City's responsibilities will result in a breach of this contract.

The purpose of this organization shall be to assist the three Member Cities to preserve

and use natural water storage and retention systems to:

1. Protect and preserve natural surface water and groundwater storage and retention systems; added water to be consistent t/o document?? Yes, for clarity.

- 3. Identify and plan for means to effectively protect and improve surface water and groundwater management;
- 4. Establish more uniform local policies and official controls for surface water and groundwater management;
- 5. Prevent erosion of soil into surface water systems;
- 6. Promote groundwater recharge;
- 7. Protect and enhance fish and wildlife habitat and water recreational facilities; Better understanding of "recreational" Language is from 103B.201
- 8. Secure other benefits associated with the proper management of surface water and groundwater; and Yes, for clarity
- 9. Promote and encourage cooperation among Member Cities in coordinating local surface water and ground water plans and awareness of their neighbors' problems concerns and to protect the public health, safety, and general welfare as it relates to water quality. Both appropriate changes.

The Lower Rum River Watershed waters flow through many sub-watersheds directly to the Rum River and the Mississippi River. It is not anticipated that the Lower Rum River Watershed Management Organization will have many capital improvement projects; if it does, it is hereby expressed that the intent of this Agreement is to encourage that the solutions should be handled by agreements between Member Cities. of the Lower Rum River WMO board. ??? I will defer to attorneys for this question. Potential issues since we do not have tax authority to undertake CIPs.

It is the intent of this Agreement to subject the Member Cities to a common set of Policies and to comply in all respects with the provisions of the Metropolitan Surface Water Management Act. Does our plan still direct to the use of this Act or does our plan direct to other Act?? Yes. It is also known as MN State Statutes 103B. We also operate concurrently under 103D (which is Watershed District Purposes). We could add this as a clarifying concept.

The purpose of this Preface is to clarify and establish for any court of review or any arbitrator or for the council members of the Member Cities the reasons and purposes for this joint

and cooperative venture. The Member Cities realize that the success or failure of the Lower Rum River Watershed Organization created by this Agreement is dependent upon the sincere desire of each Member City to cooperate in the exercise of a joint power to solve joint problems. Each Member City hereby agrees to be bound by this agreement and pledges its cooperation.

JOINT AND COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

The parties to this Agreement are governmental unit of the State of Minnesota, all of which have lands that drain surface water within the Lower Rum River Watershed and all of which have power and responsibility to construct, reconstruct, extend and maintain storm water management facilities to improve water quality, to promote groundwater recharge, and to protect, promote and preserve water resources within the Watershed. This agreement is made pursuant to the authority of Minnesota Statutes 2012, Sections 103B.201 through Section 103B.255 and Section 471.59.

NAME

I.

The parties hereby create and establish the Lower Rum River Watershed Management Organization.

GENERAL PURPOSE

II.

The general purpose of this agreement is to provide an organization that can investigate, Study, plan and control-permit or control by permit Yes, for clarity, the construction of facilities to drain or pond

storm waters, to alleviate

damage by flood waters; to improve the creek channels for drainage; to assist in planning for land use; to repair, improve, relocate, modify, consolidate or abandon, in whole or in part, drainage systems within the watershed area; to do whatever is necessary to assist in water conservation and the abatement of surface water and groundwater contamination and water pollution and the improvement of water quality; to promote ground water recharge; and to protect and enhance fish and wildlife habitat and water recreational facilities. In addition to the aforestated purposes, the organization hereby created shall serve as the watershed management organization for the Lower Rum River Watershed and shall carry out all of the duties and responsibilities outlined in Minnesota Statutes, Sections 103B.201 through 103B. 255.

DEFINITIONS

III.

For the purposes of this Agreement, the terms used herein shall have the meanings as defined in this article.

Subdivision 1. "Lower Rum River Watershed Management Organization" or "LRRWMO" means the organization created by this agreement. It shall be a public agency of its Members and a watershed management organization a defined in Minnesota Statutes, Section 103B.211.

Subdivision 2. "Board" means the Board of Commissioners of the LRRWMO, consisting of one Commissioner from each Member City or, in the absence of that Commissioner, that Member City's Alternate Commissioner. The Board shall be the governing body of the LRRWMO.

Subdivision 3. "Council" means the governing body of a Member City.

Subdivision 4. "Member City" means a city that enters into this agreement.

Subdivision 5. "Lower Rum River Watershed" or "Watershed" means the area generally contained within a line drawn around the extremities of all terrain with surface drainage that is tributary to the Lower Rum River and the Mississippi River and within the mapped areas delineated on the map filed with the Board of Water and Soil Resources originally filed pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 473.877, Subd. 2 and now amended by Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 103B, as such map has been amended with approval of the Board of Soil and Water Resources.

MEMBERSHIP

IV.

Subdivision 1. The Member Cities of the LRRWMO shall be the City of Andover, the City of Anoka and the City of Ramsey, Minnesota. Yes, for clarity.

Subdivision 2. The LRRWMO may, with the ratification of the Councils of all Member Cities, invite other units of government within the Rum River Watershed to become parties to this Agreement, and in all respects thenceforth enjoy the full rights, duties, and obligations of this Agreement.

Subdivision 3. No change in government boundaries, structure or organizational status shall affect the eligibility of the Member City to be represented on the LRRWMO, so long as such Member City continues to exist as a separate political subdivision.

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS V.

Subdivision 1. The governing body of the LRRWMO shall be its Board. Each Member City shall be entitled to appoint one representative on the Board, and one alternate who may sit when the representative is not in attendance and said representative or alternate representative shall be called a "Commissioner" and Alternate Commissioner", respectively.

Subdivision 2. The Council of each Member City shall determine the eligibility or

103B.201 METROPOLITAN WATER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM; PURPOSE.

The purposes of the water management programs required by sections 103B.205 to 103B.255 are to:

(1) protect, preserve, and use natural surface water and groundwater storage and retention systems;

(2) minimize public capital expenditures needed to correct flooding and water quality problems;

(3) identify and plan for means to effectively protect and improve surface water and groundwater quality;

(4) establish more uniform local policies and official controls for surface water and groundwater management;

(5) prevent erosion of soil into surface water systems;

(6) promote groundwater recharge;

(7) protect and enhance fish and wildlife habitat and water recreational facilities; and

(8) secure the other benefits associated with the proper management of surface water and groundwater.

103D.201 WATERSHED DISTRICT PURPOSES.

Subdivision 1. General purposes.

To conserve the natural resources of the state by land use planning, flood control, and other conservation projects by using sound scientific principles for the protection of the public health and welfare and the provident use of the natural resources, the establishment of watershed districts is authorized under this chapter.

Subd. 2. Specific purposes.

A watershed district may be established for any of the following purposes:

(1) to control or alleviate damage from floodwaters;

(2) to improve stream channels for drainage, navigation, and any other public purpose;

- (3) to reclaim or fill wet and overflowed land;
- (4) to provide a water supply for irrigation;
- (5) to regulate the flow of streams and conserve the streams' water;
- (6) to divert or change all or part of watercourses;

(7) to provide or conserve water supply for domestic, industrial, recreational, agricultural, or other public use;

(8) to provide for sanitation and public health, and regulate the use of streams, ditches, or watercourses to dispose of waste;

(9) to repair, improve, relocate, modify, consolidate, and abandon all or part of drainage systems within a watershed district;

(10) to control or alleviate soil erosion and siltation of watercourses or water basins;

(11) to regulate improvements by riparian property owners of the beds, banks, and shores of lakes, streams, and wetlands for preservation and beneficial public use;

(12) to provide for hydroelectric power generation;

(13) to protect or enhance the water quality in watercourses or water basins; and

(14) to provide for the protection of groundwater and regulate its use to preserve it for beneficial purposes.
